Thus, maximizing efficiency in food production, ensuring more effective food distribution by means of increased exports and imports between countries and ensuring food is delivered in the safest manner to customers, become increasingly important. And with our WorldFood Istanbul Exhibition which we've been organizing for the last 24 years, and the sector-related activities organized as part of the exhibition, our goal is to help increase food awareness in society. With our exhibition which we'll be organizing for the 25<sup>th</sup> time in 2017, we aim to offer opportunities for international cooperation and help increase exports among countries by adding value to the development process of the food industry".
